

Something they can work on large scale like a poster board is easier to hang than small individual pieces, but it can be done it both ways.

Rainbow/Monochromatic self-portraits. Assign each grade level a color of the rainbow and display in rainbow order. Makes a great hallway display! Some have done this on colored sticky notes and on smaller cut white paper.



Kandinsky/Matisse Abstract murals. Involvement across all grade levels minus kindergarten.

Tips:

Have the group write their rotation day on the back along with their table name on the slick side of the posterboard.

Grade levels will use organic and geometric shapes along with lines to draw an abstract design. Sharing parts of completion such as drawing, outlining, painting, and coloring across grade level sessions throughout the day until completed.
